APPLICABILITY

Applicable as a rider to the following base rates of the Company: LGS-LV, LGS-EH-LV, LGS-HV, LGS-EH-HV, and LGS-TOU (each individually a Large Business Base Rate and collectively Large Business Base Rates). All terms and conditions of the Large Business Base Rates under which the customer takes service shall remain applicable, except that the incentive specified below shall begin with commencement of service pursuant to the contract for new electric service. A customer can receive only one (1) incentive per premises. Rider LBR shall not be combined with the following Rate Riders of the Company: SR, OWD, and LLF.

AVAILABILITY

Available in all areas served by the Company. This Rider is available to customers initiating service under the Large Business Base Rates above that employ a minimum of 20 full-time employees, and that enter into a contract for new electric service commencing prior to January 1, 2013 at qualifying locations to serve Qualifying New Load as defined in this Rider. An employee working 30 hours or more per week constitutes one full-time employee. This Rider is not available to a new customer that results from a change in ownership of an existing establishment or the relocation of an existing establishment or existing electrical equipment that is currently served by the Company. The discounts below shall not be available to any new service established prior to the effective date of this Rider. Customers with monthly peak demand in excess of 10,000 kVA shall be eligible for this Rider at the option of Company.

MONTHLY BILLING DISCOUNT

Subject to compliance with the terms and conditions hereof and the execution of an associated contract for service as described herein, the customer will receive a discount to the Large Business Base Rate revenues before adjustments and taxes (base bill) in accordance with the following schedule:

Percent Discount of Base Bill

<u>Billing Months</u>	<u>Discount</u>
1-12	20%
13-24	15%
25-36	10%

The customer's monthly base bill will be reduced by this discount as calculated above; provided, however, that no monthly bill shall be reduced beyond the minimum bill amount calculated under the applicable Large Business Base Rate.

QUALIFYING ELECTRIC LOAD

Qualifying New Load under this Rider shall be limited to new business load (i) that is to be served in existing buildings situated within the service area of the Company, (ii) where such existing building has been unoccupied or dormant for the previous six (6) months, (iii) where the Company has in place electric service facilities of adequate voltage and capacity (at existing building) to serve the new load without the need for replacement or upgrade; and (iv) that is served through a single meter.

TERM

Customers signing a new five (5) year electric service contract under the applicable Large Business Base Rate are eligible to receive discounts under the rider during the first thirty-six (36) months of the contract term. This Rider will terminate at the earlier of: (i) expiration of thirty-six (36) months from initial service under the Large Business Base Rate, or (ii) termination by the Commission as provided by law, and the customer will continue to be served under the applicable Large Business Base Rate schedule without the monthly discount provided herein. Should the customer wish to terminate service anytime during the initial thirty-six (36) months of service, customer shall be subject to the billing requirements of the Large Business Base Rate schedule without regard to this Rider.

The contract for service under this rider must be executed by an authorized representative of customer's company, and must be accompanied by a written statement attesting to the number of permanent full-time employees as defined herein.

If during the term this Rider is in effect another rate for which the customer qualifies should become available that is more cost-effective for the customer and to which this Rider does not apply, the customer may elect to change to the more cost-effective rate with no penalty under this Rider. The incentive provided hereunder shall cease when the rate change is made effective, and the minimum term of service under the more cost-effective rate shall be the greater of this new rate's minimum term of service or the unexpired term of service from the previous Large Business Base Rate.

Service under this rider schedule is subject to Service Rules of the Company
