



The Gulfport-Biloxi International Airport Site is comprised of 241 developable acres adjacent to the airport's 9,000-foot runway. This site is owned by Gulfport-Biloxi International Airport and is in close proximity to rail service by the Kansas City Southern main line railroad. Strategically located in Harrison County within two miles of I-10 and the newly expanded Port of Gulfport, this site provides easy access to the Gulf of Mexico flight test range for commercial and unmanned aerial vehicle testing.
