



SOUTH MISSISSIPPI INDUSTRIAL RAIL SITE

LUCEDALE, MS 39452

353 acres / 136.78 hectares





Located within the 1,200-acre George County Industrial Park, this site offers 353 developable acres owned by the Mississippi Export Railroad. The Mississippi Export Railroad offers a 42-mile shortline railroad that extends from the George County Industrial Park to the Port of Pascagoula. This is a rail-served site with connections to Canadian National, CSX, Kansas City Southern and Norfolk Southern. All utilities extend to the site boundaries along with a completed rail spur. This site is within five miles of Mississippi Highway 63 and less than three miles from the U.S. Highway 98 corridor which connects to four Metropolitan Statistical Areas in the region.
